

End of Term 2 - February 19th 2025, with report cards available on the portal onFeb. 28th 2025. This term is weighted at 20% of the year's final mark.

End of Term 3 - June 23rd 2025, with report cards available on the portal on June 30th 2025. This term is weighted at 60% of year's final mark.

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

How Can Parents Support Anxious Kids and Help Them Thrive?


